


Greetings

Program Objectives


KICTE has provided professional training program for the public officials and the engineers upon request by international organization.

Through this program, KICTE shares and introduces Korea's policies, construction technology, workforces, and its related systems for participants to be a future leader in the partners' country.


Our program offers specially designed program in terms of two days to one week in compliance with the participants' needs.
